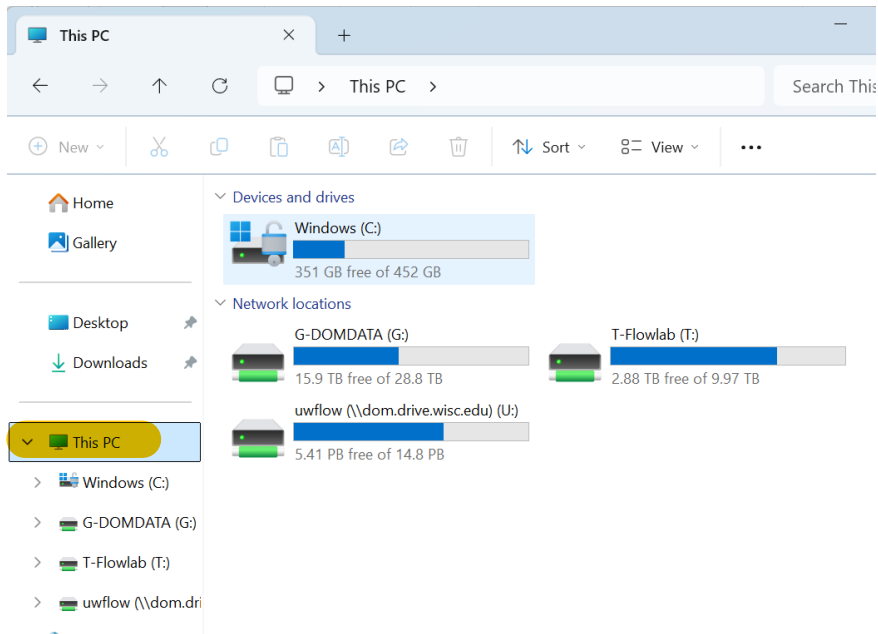
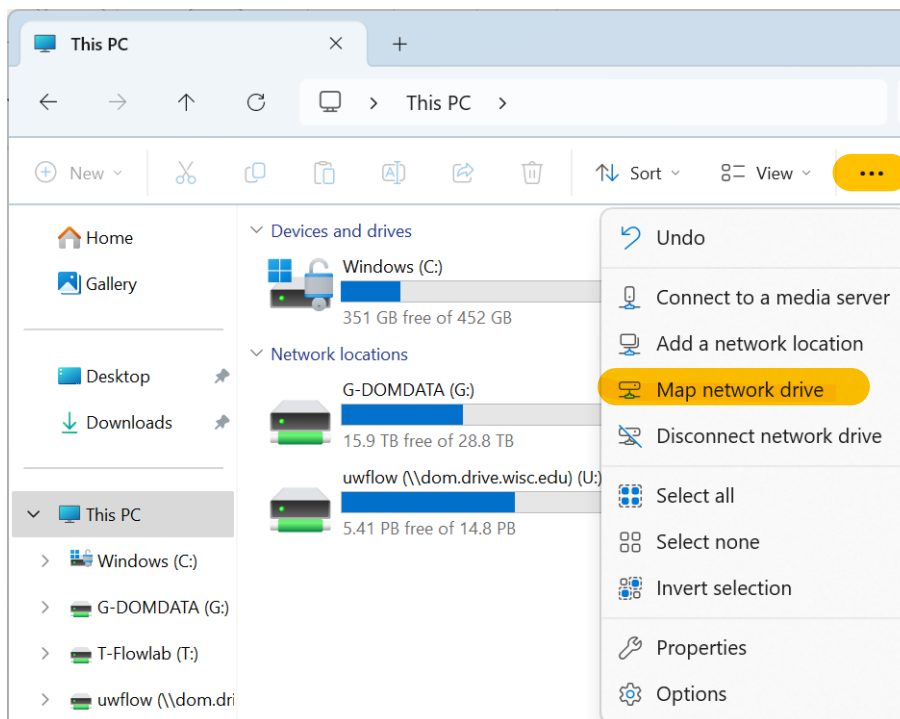


Mapping UWFLOW from a Windows computer

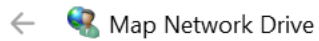
1. If you are off campus or using wifi then you will need to connect to [WiscVPN](#) before using ResearchDrive.
2. Open a File Explorer window and click on This PC in the left column



3. Click the three dots at the top of the window to “see more” and select **Map network drive**



4. Select a drive letter and enter **\\dom.drive.wisc.edu\UWFLOW**



5. Ensure that the **Reconnect at logon** box is checked.
6. Check the box labeled **Connect using different credentials**.

7. Click **Finish**.
