

Mapping UWFLOW from a Windows computer


- 1. If you are off campus or using wifi then you will need to connect to <u>WiscVPN</u> before using ResearchDrive.
- 2. Open a File Explorer window and click on This PC in the left column



Click the three dots at the top of the window to "see more" and select Map network drive





4. Select a drive letter and enter \\dom.drive.wisc.edu\UWFLOW



What network folder would you like to map?


Specify the drive letter for the connection and the folder that you want to connect to:





- 5. Ensure that the **Reconnect at logon** box is checked.
- 6. Check the box labeled **Connect using different credentials**.

7. Click Finish.
